
Heavily soiled or non-cleanable items (oil bottles, etc.) have to be disposed as "Burnable Garbage

Dispose the items without [3] mark as "Burnable Garbage" (such as buckets and plastic washbowls, etc.)

Make an easy carrying bundle of papers by type and tie it

Rip other materials (such as plastic, cloth, leather, or metal)


