

Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc. Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm<sup>2</sup>. Do not bundle them. Large Items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, considered as "Over-sized Trash."


