Burnable Garbage	Kitchen waste, waste paper, chunks of wood, pieces of cloth, plastic items, leather items, shells, rubber goods, aluminum foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc. Kitchen waste should be well dried. Remove feces from used disposable diapers. Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm. Do not bundle them. Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, considered as "Over-sized Trash." 	 <p>もえるごみ専用指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Non-burnable Garbage	Iron scraps, pans, kettles, scissors, knives, razors, spray cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spray cans must be used up completely and make a hole in cans to take all the gas out outside away from flames. Knives should be wrapped with papers etc. Cans larger size than 18L should be disposed as "Over-sized Trash" Top to the can goods and top to the twisted type bottle must be disposed as "Metal Items." The small household electrical appliances are not considered as "Metal Items." 	 <p>もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Glass and Crockery	Electric bulbs, broken or dirty glass bottles, plates, glasses, bowls, vases, opalescent glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Empty garbage items Remove caps and plastic tops. Large pieces should be broken into smaller pieces to prevent the bag from tearing. Do not wrap with papers and show the contents. Glass and crockery can be put in a bag. Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs (Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery." 	 <p>もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Ash	Ashes of oval briquettes, wood burning stoves, wood burning bath, and charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extinguish the fire in ashes completely. The burnt residue are considered as "Burnable Garbage." 	 <p>Non-burnable Garbage/ Recyclable Garbage Bag</p>
Recyclable Garbage	Plastic containers and packaging with ♻️ mark packing trays, cups, bottles, styrene foam, labels, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use designated bags specified for plastic containers and packaging (Use also city-specified bags used for recyclable garbage). Rinse well and dry the items. Do not put garbage in multiple supermarket bags etc. (Do not double-bags) No need to remove paper price tags or barcode labels. Heavily soiled or non-cleanable items (oil bottles, etc.) have to be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" Dispose the items without ♻️ mark as "Burnable Garbage" (such as buckets and plastic washbowls, etc.). 	 <p>もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Clothing and Fabric	Clothes, trousers, bed sheets, curtains, blankets, sweaters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Put into the bag specified for non-burnable garbage without cutting up and close the bag tightly. Underwear, socks, heavily soiled or torn items should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" 	 <p>もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Glass Bottles	Unbroken bottles for food /drinks and for cosmetics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Separate by colors: colorless and white, brown, and others. Remove the top from the bottle, rinse well, and dry. No need to remove labels. Glass bottles with colorless spouts are sorted into "Colorless Glass Bottles" Broken glass bottles, cooking oil glass bottles and opalescent glass bottles are sorted into "Glass and Crockery" 	 <p>もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Electric Batteries	Manganese cells, Nickel-Cadmium rechargeable batteries, alkaline batteries, mercury batteries, button cells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Button cells and small charger type cells need to be insulated by wrapping adhesive tape around. Fluorescent Tubes	Long fluorescent tubes, round-shaped fluorescent tubes, bulb shaped fluorescent lights, Germicidal lamp, ultraviolet germicidal lamp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs (Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery." Fluorescent tubes can be collected with their original paper cases. How to distinguish between a bulb shaped fluorescent light and an incandescent lamp: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A bulb-shaped fluorescent light has a plastic part between the bulb and the metal but the incandescent lamp doesn't. Model number of a bulb shaped fluorescent light begins with "EF-" Disposal LED bulbs (made of plastic) as "used small home appliances." 	
Recyclable Garbage	Newspapers, Cardboard, Magazines and other papers, Paper cartons, Paper containers and packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make an easy carrying bundle of papers by type and tie it crosswise to dispose. Rip other materials (such as plastic, cloth, leather, or metal) off and dispose respectively. No need to remove staples from magazines or other papers. No need to remove staples, packing tapes or labels from cardboard boxes. Even papers with corrugated cross section (wavy) are sorted into "Paper containers and packaging" if they have ♻️ mark. Japanese papers, thermal papers, photographs, rice/fertilizer bags and papers coated with plastic should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" Wrap and toilet paper tubes should be disposed as "Magazines and other papers" Rinse, cut to open, and dry paper cartons. Tie them crosswise to dispose. Shop front collection is also recommended. Small items should be flattened and put into other wrappings, or put in a paper bag with ♻️ mark and tie it crosswise to dispose. Dirty, metal and plastics should be removed from items. 	
PET Bottles	Plastic PET bottles with ♻️ mark	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic tops and labels are disposed as "Plastic Containers and Packaging." Plastic rings don't have to be taken, but labels must be removed. Lightly rinse and dry containers. Soiled bottles should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" 	
Cans	Juice or alcohol cans, food cans, confectionary cans, milk cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lightly rinse and dry them. No need to separate aluminum cans from steel cans. Top to the can goods and top to the twisted type bottle must be disposed as "Metal Items." 	
Used Small Household Appliances	Cell phones, electric razors, calculators, game machines, PCs, digital cameras, hair driers, flashlights, clocks, vacuum cleaners, rice cookers, car audios, electric cords, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recycling centers accept all items of used small household appliances. Open: according to business hours of each recycling center (9:00am-4:00pm) Complete registration first, then follow the staff's instructions and put your items in the provided container. These recycle boxes in main city office and city branch office collect items within 15cm height x 35cm width x 25cm depth. Bring larger items into a respective recycling center. Open: Monday to Friday (8:30am-5:15pm) 	
Waste Cooking Oil	Used or expired cooking oil (Vegetable oil only)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please bring the item to the main city hall, city branch offices, or each recycling center. 	
Waste Bicycle	Unnecessary Bicycle (Broken bicycles are accepted)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bring it to a respective recycling center during its open hours. 	
Garden Waste Recycling	Tree branches with diameter in 1-8cm. Thinner ones as burnable garbage, thicker ones as over-sized trash or thermal recycling wood chips.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open: 9:00 am-4:00 pm on each Recycling Center collection days. Remove leaves, cut out branches, make them into handy length, and bundle with strings. Woodchips are available for free at each Recycling Center.
