<b>Burnable Garbage</b>	Kitchen waste, waste paper, chunks of wood, pieces of cloth, plastic items, leather items, shells, rubber goods, aluminum foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc.</li> <li>Kitchen waste should be well dried.</li> <li>Remove feces from used disposable diapers.</li> <li>Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm. Do not bundle them.</li> <li>Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, considered as "Over-sized Trash."</li> </ul>	もえるごみ専用指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
<b>Non-burnable Garbage</b>	Iron scraps, pans, kettles, scissors, knives, razors, spray cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Spray cans must be used up completely and make a hole in cans to take all the gas out outside away from flames.</li> <li>Knives should be wrapped with papers etc.</li> <li>Cans larger size than 18L should be disposed as "Over-sized Trash."</li> <li>Top to the can goods and top to the twisted type bottle must be disposed as "Metal Items."</li> <li>The small household electrical appliances are not considered as "Metal Items."</li> </ul>	もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
<b>Glass and Crockery</b>	Electric bulbs, broken or dirty glass bottles, plates, glasses, bowls, vases, opalescent glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Empty garbage items</li> <li>Remove caps and plastic tops.</li> <li>Large pieces should be broken into smaller pieces to prevent the bag from tearing.</li> <li>Do not wrap with papers and show the contents.</li> <li>Glass and crockery can be put together in one bag.</li> <li>Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs(Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery."</li> </ul>	もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
<b>Ash</b>	Ashes of oval briquettes, wood burning stoves, wood burning bath, and charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extinguish the fire in ashes completely.</li> <li>The burnt residue are considered as "Burnable Garbage."</li> </ul>	Non-burnable Garbage/ Recyclable Garbage Bag
<b>Recyclable Garbage</b>	Long fluorescent tubes, round-shaped fluorescent tubes, bulb shaped fluorescent lights, Germicidal lamp, ultraviolet germicidal lamp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs(Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery."</li> <li>Fluorescent tubes can be collected with their paper cases.</li> <li>How to distinguish between a bulb shaped fluorescent light and an incandescent lamp</li> <li>A bulb-shaped fluorescent light has a plastic part between the bulb and the metal but the incandescent lamp doesn't.</li> <li>Model number of a bulb shaped fluorescent light begins with "EF-"</li> <li>Pls dispose LED bulbs (made of plastic) as "used small home appliances."</li> </ul>	
<b>Electric Batteries</b>	Manganese cells, Nickel-Cadmium rechargeable batteries, alkaline batteries, mercury batteries, button cells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Button cells and small charger type cells need to be insulated by wrapping adhesive tape around.</li> <li>Car and motor bike batteries are sorted into "Over-sized Trash"</li> </ul>	
<b>Plastic Containers and Packaging</b>	Plastic containers and packaging with ♻️ mark packing trays, cups, bottles, styrene foam, labels, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Use designated bags specified for plastic containers and packaging (Use also city-specified bags used for recyclable garbage.)</li> <li>Rinse well and dry the items.</li> <li>Do not put garbage in multiple supermarket bags etc. (Do not double-bags)</li> <li>No need to remove paper price tags or barcode labels.</li> <li>Heavily soiled or non-cleanable items (oil bottles, etc.) have to be disposed as "Burnable Garbage"</li> <li>Dispose the items without ♻️ mark as "Burnable Garbage" (such as buckets and plastic washbowls, etc.).</li> </ul>	専用袋 (安曇野市) Area Name

<b>Cans</b>	Juice or alcohol cans, food cans, confectionary cans, milk cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lightly rinse and dry them.</li> <li>No need to separate aluminum cans from steel cans.</li> <li>Top to the can goods and top to the twisted type bottle must be disposed as "Metal Items."</li> </ul>	
<b>Glass Bottles</b>	Unbroken bottles for food / drinks and for cosmetics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Separate by colors: colorless and white, brown, and others.</li> <li>Remove the top from the bottle, rinse well, and dry. No need to remove labels.</li> <li>Glass bottles with colorless spouts are sorted into "Colorless Glass Bottles"</li> <li>Broken glass bottles cooking oil glass bottles and opalescent glass bottles are sorted into "Glass and Crockery"</li> </ul>	
<b>PET Bottles</b>	Plastic PET bottles with ♻️ mark	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Plastic tops and labels are disposed as "Plastic Containers and Packaging"</li> <li>Plastic rings don't have to be taken, but labels must be removed.</li> <li>Lightly rinse and dry containers.</li> <li>Soiled bottles should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage"</li> </ul>	
<b>Clothing and Fabrics</b>	Clothes, trousers, bed sheets, curtains, blankets, sweaters	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Put into the bag specified for non-burnable garbage/ Recyclable Garbage without cutting up and close the bag tightly.</li> <li>Underwear, socks, heavily soiled or torn items should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage"</li> </ul>	もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
<b>Newspapers</b>	Newspapers and newspaper inserts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make an easy carrying bundle of papers by type and tie it crosswise to dispose.</li> <li>Rip other materials (such as plastic, cloth, leather, or metal) off and dispose respectively.</li> <li>No need to remove staples from magazines or other papers.</li> <li>No need to remove staples, packing tapes or labels from cardboard boxes.</li> <li>Even papers with corrugated cross section (wavy) are sorted into "Paper containers and packaging" if they have ♻️ mark.</li> <li>Japanese papers, thermal papers, photographs, rice/fertilizer bags and papers coated with plastic should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage"</li> <li>Wrap and toilet paper tubes should be disposed as "Magazines and other papers"</li> </ul>	
<b>Cardboard</b>	with corrugated cross section		
<b>Magazines and other papers</b>	Magazines, books, catalogs, brochures, other papers		
<b>Paper cartons</b>	Paper cartons (milk, fruit juice)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rinse, cut to open, and dry paper cartons. Tie them crosswise to dispose.</li> <li>Shop front collection is also recommended.</li> </ul>	
<b>Paper containers and packaging</b>	Empty paper boxes/ bags/ packaging	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Small items should be flatten and put into other wrappings, or put in a paper bag with ♻️ mark and tie it crosswise to dispose.</li> <li>Dirt, metal and plastics should be removed from items.</li> </ul>	Paper containers and packaging with ♻️ mark
<b>Used Small Household Appliances</b>	Cell phones, electric razors, calculators, game machines, PCs, digital cameras, hair driers, flashlights, clocks, vacuum cleaners, rice cookers, car audios, electric cords, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recycling centers accept all items of used small household appliances. Open: according to business hours of each recycling center. (9:00am-4:00pm)</li> <li>Complete registration first, then follow the staff's instructions and put your items in the provided container.</li> <li>These recycle boxes in main city office and city branch office collect items within 15cm height x 35cm width x 25cm depth. Bring larger items into a respective recycling center. Open: Monday to Friday (8:30am-5:15pm)</li> </ul>	Recycling Center Recycle Box in Main City Office/ City Branch Office
<b>Waste Cooking Oil</b>	Used or expired cooking oil (Vegetable oil only)	Please bring the item to the main city hall, city branch offices, or each recycling center.	
<b>Waste Bicycle</b>	Unnecessary Bicycle (Broken bicycles are accepted)	Bring it to a respective recycling center during its open hours.	
<b>Garden Waste Recycling (to chip pruned branches)</b>	Tree branches with diameter in 1~8cm. Thinner ones as burnable garbage, thicker ones as over-sized trash or thermal recycling wood chips.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open 9:00 am-4:00 pm on each Recycling Center collection days.</li> <li>Remove leaves, cut out branches, make them into handy length, and bundle with strings.</li> <li>Woodchips are available for free at each Recycling Center.</li> </ul>	Each Recycling Center

<b>Burnable Over-sized Trash</b> Futon, Tatami, wooden furniture, wood, etc.	Take directly to Hotaka Clean Center	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Acceptable trash: large trash that doesn't fit in the city-issued burnable garbage bag.</li> <li>* Max. size accepted: length 2m x width 1.2m x height 1m. <b>Thermal recycling of wood chips</b>	Bring the trash on your own for disposal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Collection Point: Toyoshina Recycling Center</li> <li>Collection Hours: 9:00am-3:30pm on business days</li> <li>Services for: households and companies handling wood chips except industrial waste within the city</li> <li>Acceptable waste: pruned branches of garden and fruits trees(thickness exceeding 8cm), logged trees, roots of trees, wooden furniture(without mirrors or glasses), other wood waste chips.</li> <li>Fee: 100yen + tax/ 5kg</li> </ul>
