	urnable arbage	Kitchen waste, waste paper, chunks of wood, pieces of cloth, leather items, shells, rubber goods, aluminum foil	ODo not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc.  Kitchen waste should be well dried.  Remove feces from used disposable diapers.  Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm². Do not bundle them.  Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, please dispose of it as "Oversized Trash."	
Non-burna	Metal Items	Iron scraps, pans, kettles, scissors, knives, razors, spray cans  Make a hole  Wrap blades with papers	Ospray cans must be used up completely and make a hole in cans to take all the gas out outside away from flames. 
