

★ Thoroughly separate garbage types and use the city-specified bags.

Take it out to the designated collection site in your area from 6:00am to 8:30am (April-Sept), 6:30am to 8:30am (October -March) on collection days. [Be responsible for your garbage by writing your name and your area on the bag.]

* The collection days for recyclables (excluding plastic resources) are different for Todoroki Machi Ward, Maki Ward, and Kubota Ward. Please check the bottom left of the calendar for details. [Tie your garbage bag before disposal of it.]

Garden Waste Recycling is accepted on collection days at each Recycling Center in Azumino.

No garbage collection from December 31 to January 4. Business waste is NOT collected at the collection points. Note: Violated garbage will be taped a warning and WILL NOT be collected.

Burnable Garbage	Kitchen waste, waste paper, chunks of wood, pieces of cloth, leather items, shells, rubber goods, aluminum foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc. Kitchen waste should be well dried. Remove feces from used disposable diapers. Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm. Do not bundle them. Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, please dispose of it as "Oversized Trash." 	 <p>もえるごみ専用指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name</p>
Non-burnable Garbage	Iron scraps, pans, kettles, scissors, knives, razors, spray cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spray cans must be used up completely and make a hole in cans to take all the gas out outside away from flames. Knives should be wrapped with papers etc. Cans larger size than 18L should be disposed as "Over-sized Trash" The lids from canned goods and twist-off bottle caps must be disposed of as "Metal Items." Glass and Crockery	Electric bulbs, broken or dirty glass bottles, plates, glasses, bowls, vases, opalescent glass bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Empty garbage items Remove caps. Large pieces should be broken into smaller pieces to prevent the bag from tearing. Do not wrap with papers and show the contents. Glass and crockery can be put in a bag. Ash	Ashes of oval briquettes, wood burning stoves, wood burning bath, and charcoal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Extinguish the fire in ashes completely. The burnt residue are considered as "Burnable Garbage." 	 <p>Non-burnable Garbage/ Recyclable Garbage Bag</p>
Plastic Recyclables	Plastic for container packaging: Trays, cups, Styrofoam, bottles, labels, etc. Plastic for products: Straws, washbasins, buckets, plastic tableware, plastic toys, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> From April 2025, plastics for product will be newly collected. Please use the plastic recyclables bag (yellow) or the non-burnable garbage and recyclables bag (blue). Rinse thoroughly and dry before disposing. No need to put in small bag beforehand. (no double bagging) No need to remove paper price tags or barcode stickers. Items either heavily soiled or with dirt not easily removed (oil bottles, etc.) should be disposed of as "burnable trash" Plastic recyclables that do not fit into designated bags can be deposited at the Toyoshina/Hotaka Recycling Center (not at the Akishina Recycling Center). Glass Bottles	Unbroken bottles for food /drinks and for cosmetics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Separate by colors: colorless and white, brown, and others. Remove the top from the bottle, rinse well, and dry. No need to remove labels. Glass bottles with colorless spouts are sorted into "Colorless Glass Bottles" Broken glass bottles, cooking oil glass bottles and opalescent glass bottles are sorted into "Glass and Crockery" 	 <p>Colorless (white) Brown colored Other colored</p>
Electric Batteries	Manganese cells, Nickel-Cadmium rechargeable batteries, alkaline batteries, mercury batteries, button cells, lithium battery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please wrap the electrodes of the button battery with tape for isolation. Car and motor bike batteries are sorted into "Over-sized Trash"

Fluorescent Tubes	Long fluorescent tubes, round-shaped fluorescent tubes, bulb shaped fluorescent lights, Germicidal lamp, ultraviolet germicidal lamp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs(Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery." Fluorescent tubes can be collected with their original paper cases. How to distinguish a bulb shaped fluorescent light and an incandescent lamp: A bulb-shaped fluorescent light has a plastic part between the bulb and the metal but the incandescent lamp doesn't. Model number of a bulb shaped fluorescent light begins with "EF-". Do not dispose LED bulbs (made of plastic) as "used small home appliances." 	
Newspapers	Newspapers and newspaper inserts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make an easy carrying bundle of papers by type and tie it crosswise to dispose. Rip other materials (such as plastic, cloth, leather, or metal) off and dispose respectively. No need to remove staples from magazines or other papers. No need to remove staples, packing tapes or labels from cardboard boxes. Even papers with corrugated cross section (wavy) are sorted into "Paper containers and packaging" if they have a ♻️ mark. Japanese papers, thermal papers, photographs, rice/fertilizer bags and papers coated with plastic should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" Wrap and toilet paper tubes should be disposed as "Magazines and other papers"

Paper cartons	Paper cartons (milk, fruit juice)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Rinse, cut to open, and dry paper cartons. Tie them crosswise to dispose. Shop front collection is also recommended. 	
Paper containers and packaging	Empty paper boxes/ bags/packaging with ♻️ mark	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Small items should be flattened and put into other wrappings, or put in a paper bag with ♻️ mark and tie it crosswise to dispose. Dirt, metal and plastics should be removed from items. 	
PET Bottles	Plastic PET bottles with ♻️ mark	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic caps and labels are disposed as "plastic recyclables." Plastic rings don't have to be taken, but labels must be removed. Lightly rinse and dry containers. Soiled bottles should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage" 	
Cans	Juice or alcohol cans, food cans, confectionary cans, milk cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lightly rinse and dry them. No need to separate aluminum cans from steel cans. The lids from canned goods and twist-off bottle caps must be disposed of as "Metal Items." 	
Used Small Household Appliances	Cell phones, electric razors, calculators, game machines, PCs, digital cameras, hair driers, flashlights, clocks, vacuum cleaners, rice cookers, car audios, electric cords, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> NO air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines/cloth driers Erase all the personal data from devices.
