Guidelines for garbage disposal Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc.)Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm². Do not bundle them. Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, please dispose of it as "Oversized Trash."

Spray cans must be used up completely and make a hole in cans to take all the gas out outside away from flames.

The lids from canned goods and twist-off bottle caps must be disposed of as "Metal items."




