

REIWA 8th 2026 Misato Area Garbage and Recyclable Garbage Collection Calendar

★Thoroughly separate garbage types and use the city-specified bags. Take it out to the designated collection site in your area from 7am to 8am on collection days.
 [Be responsible for your garbage by writing your name and your area on the bag.] [Tie your garbage bag before disposal of it.]

Let's be more conscious and do what we can as an individual to reduce food waste.

Garden Waste Recycling is accepted on collection days at each Recycling Center in Azumino.

Classification	Main Items	Guidelines for garbage disposal	What to use for disposal
Burnable Garbage	Kitchen waste, waste paper, chunks of wood, pieces of cloth, leather items, shells, rubber goods, aluminum foil	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do not cover or hide your garbage with newspapers etc. Kitchen waste should be well dried. Remove feces from used disposable diapers. Wood and branches should be no bigger than 5cm in diameter and 50cm in length. Boards should be cut into pieces within 50cm. Do not bundle them. Large items such as futons, carpet, wood, etc. will be collected if the item is small enough to fit into the city-issued burnable garbage bag, if not, please dispose of it as "Oversized Trash." 	もえるごみ専用指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
Non-burnable Garbage	Glass and Crockery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Empty garbage items Remove caps. Large pieces should be broken into smaller pieces to prevent the bag from tearing. Do not wrap with papers and show the contents. Glass and crockery can be put in a bag. 	Ash	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ashes of oval briquettes, wood burning stoves, wood burning bath, and charcoal 	Non-burnable Garbage/Recyclable Garbage Bag
	Metal Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Iron scraps, pans, kettles, scissors, knives, razors, spray cans Wrap blades with papers. Make a hole. 	もえないごみ資源物指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
Recyclable Garbage	Cans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Juice or alcohol cans, food cans, confectionary cans, milk cans Lightly rinse and dry them. No need to separate aluminum cans from steel cans. The lids from canned goods and twist-off bottle caps must be disposed of as "Metal Items". 	PET Bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic PET bottles with PET mark Plastic caps and labels are disposed as "plastic recyclables". 	Plastic Recyclables	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Plastic for container packaging: Trays, cups, Styrofoam, bottles, labels, etc. Plastic for products: Straws, washbasins, buckets, plastic tableware, plastic toys, etc. 	プラスチック資源物専用指定袋 (安曇野市) Area Name
Fluorescent Tubes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Long fluorescent tubes, round-shaped fluorescent tubes, bulb shaped fluorescent lights Incandescent light bulbs, LED light bulbs (Glass), glow lamps, and broken fluorescent tubes should be disposed as "Glass and Crockery." Fluorescent tubes can be collected with their paper cases. How to distinguish a bulb-shaped fluorescent light and an incandescent lamp: A bulb-shaped fluorescent light has a plastic part between the bulb and the metal but the incandescent lamp doesn't. Recyclable Garbage	Electric Batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Manganese cells, Nickel-Cadmium rechargeable batteries, alkaline batteries, mercury batteries, button cells, lithium battery Please wrap the electrodes of the button batteries and lithium-ion batteries with tape for isolation. 	Glass Bottles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Unbroken bottles for food /drinks and for cosmetics Separate by colors: colorless and white, brown, and others. Remove the top from the bottle, rinse well, and dry. No need to remove labels. Glass bottles with colorless spouts are sorted into "Colorless Glass Bottles". 	Clothing and Fabric	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clothes, trousers, bed sheets, curtains, blankets, sweaters Put into the bag specified for non-burnable garbage/Recyclable Garbage without cutting up and close the bag tightly. 	Newspapers	Newspapers and newspaper inserts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make an easy carrying bundle of papers by type and tie it crosswise to dispose. Rip other materials (such as plastic, cloth, leather, or metal) off and dispose respectively. No need to remove staples from magazines or other papers. No need to remove staples, packing tapes or labels from cardboard boxes. Even papers with corrugated cross section (wavy) are sorted into "Paper Containers and Packaging" if they have ♻️ mark. Japanese papers, thermal papers, photographs, rice/fertilizer bags and papers coated with plastic should be disposed as "Burnable Garbage". Used Small Household Appliances	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cell phones, electric razors, calculators, game machines, PCs, digital cameras, hair driers, flashlights, clocks, vacuum cleaners, rice cookers, car audios, electric cords, etc. *NO air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators/freezers, washing machines/cloth driers *Erase all the personal data from devices. *Remove all batteries/ fluorescent tubes. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Recycling centers accept all items of used small household appliances. Garden Waste Recycling (to chip pruned branches)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tree branches with diameter in 1~8cm. Thinner ones as burnable garbage, thicker ones as over-sized trash or thermal recycling wood chips. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Open 9:00 am-4:00 pm on each Recycling Center collection days.
